Learning to Understand The Ministry of Healing

During this retreat, you will learn how Jesus sent out His disciples to “make disciples of all nations” (*Matt. 28: 19*). Jesus healed the lame, the maimed, the blind, the mute and many others as the people put them at His feet, He healed them” (*Matt. 15: 29 – 31*). He also healed the paralysed (*Mark 2: 1 – 12*), the lepers (*Matt. 8: 1 – 4*) and brought the dead back to life (*Matt. 9: 24 – 25*).

Today, Jesus desires to come into our hearts. He is “standing at the door of our hearts and knocking” hoping that we will hear and “open the door” so that “He can come in” (*Rev. 3: 20*).
